EPS supports multiple payment options, including mobile check deposit; offers more reporting features; and allows customers to manage multiple USPS business functions under one account.

Enterprise Payment System

**All eligible products must migrate from CAPS to EPS effective
April 1, 2019**

**All new accounts must be established through EPS effective
September 1, 2018**

The major eligible products and services include:

- First-Class Mail[®] letters, cards, and flats
- USPS Marketing Mail[™] letters, flats, and parcels
- Bound Printed Matter
- Periodicals
- Business Reply Mail (BRM)
- Every Door Direct Mail (EDDM[®]), submitted via hard copy
- and many other USPS products.
